

Attached is a list of suggested titles for summer reading. These books and a multitude of other titles can be found in one of the district's free digital resources by going to http://read.dadeschools.net.


MyOn Logs will be graded during the first week of school and are due on the first day of school.

MyON is a complete literacy solution that reinvents the ways in which students and teachers interact with text. MyON provides anytime, anywhere access to a library of more than 8,000 enhanced digital books with multimedia supports, real-time reporting and assessments and embedded close reading tools.

Please visit http://www.dadeschools.net and login through the student portal. Click Apps/Sites/Services/ on the top left menu. Scroll down to locate and click on MyOn.

Username and password is the student's ID Number.

Students are encouraged to read 2-4 books a week on myON, including a minimum of one non-fiction book. For fiction books, choose books on 4th grade level that are worth at least 1 AR point. For non-fiction books, choose books that are worth at least half a point. To verify the AR points and grade level, go to î to check the book information.

Please use the log to record the books you read. Write the number of stars you would award the story: 1 star = I didn't like the story; 2 stars = the story was good; 3 stars = the story was the best and I would love to read it again.

Turn in completed Logs to your Reading Teacher to begin the year with an extra credit A!

Summer Tips for Success with Reflex!



- Your child can utilize the Reflex math program from any device with internet access throughout the summer, including smartphones.
- Reflex helps students of all ability levels to develop fluency with their basic facts in addition, subtraction, multiplication and division.
