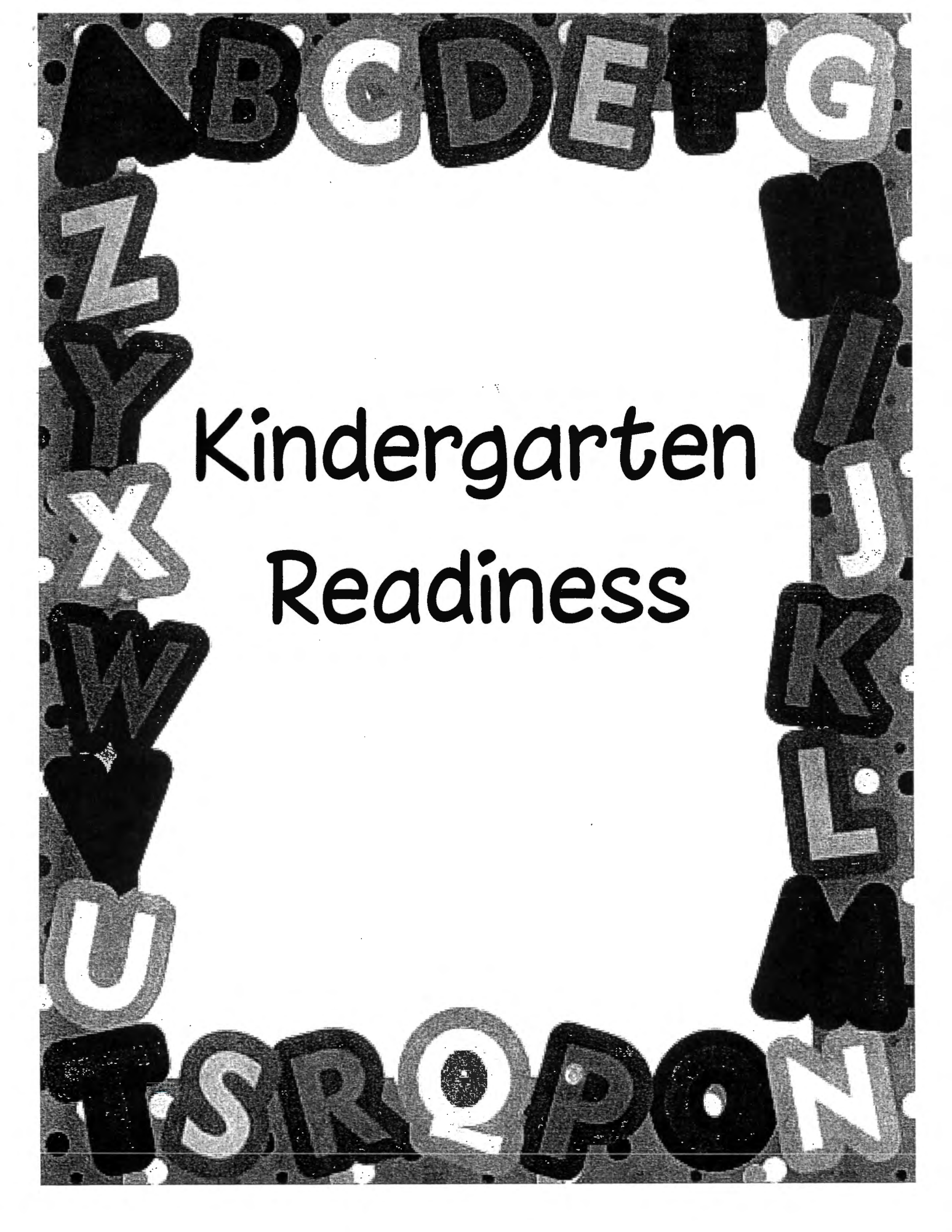
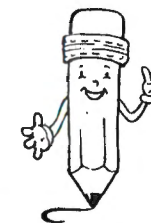

Row 1: Number 0. Shows stroke order (1: counter-clockwise curve, 2: close the loop). Includes solid, dashed, and dotted versions.

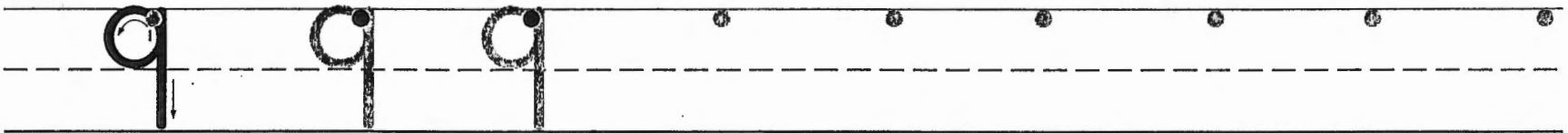
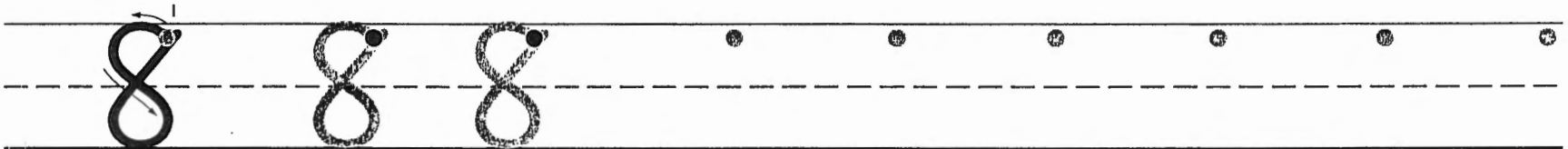
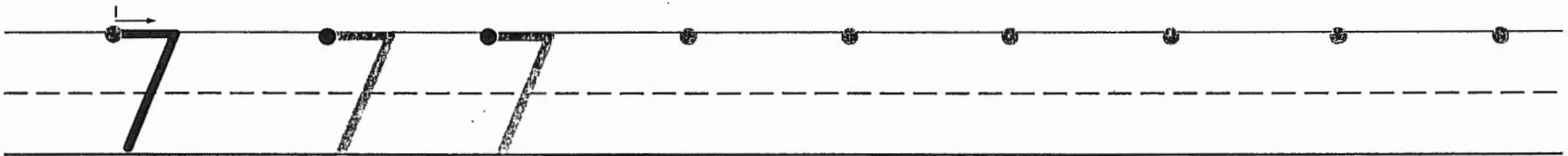
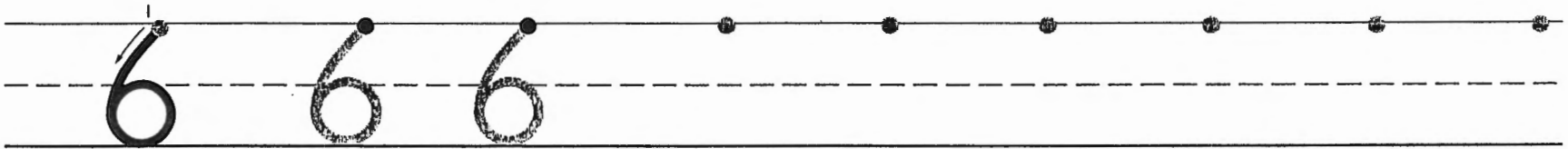
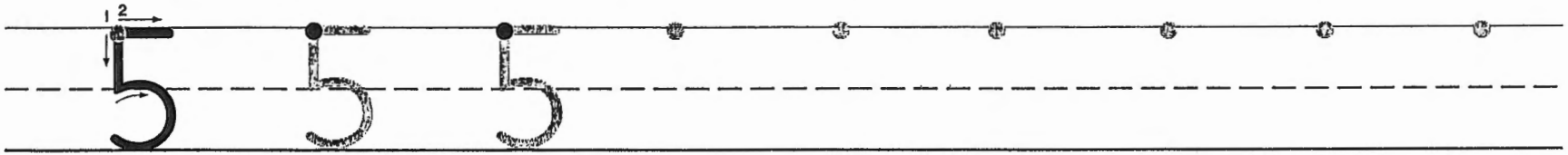
